When Worthwhile Wear set out to help survivors of human trafficking, we didn't try to reinvent the wheel but instead sought to organize the many "spokes" to make the "wheel" more effective. We made partnerships with local area service providers and took notes from leading organizations already caring for survivors across the country. We came to learn that survivors would benefit most from having curriculum developed by another survivor. The "Ending the Game" curriculum, written by Rachel Thomas, is what we use at The Well and in the Worth It program to teach survivors about psychological coercion and equip them with the tools to undo the effects of their exploitation.

On Thursday, November 14 guests at our 8th annual fundraiser, A Worthwhile Evening, will hear Rachel Thomas share her personal story and her journey to embracing true survivorhood. Thomas' curriculum has shaped and impacted participants in our programs in incredibly meaningful ways. We are honored to have her join us for this special evening.
